FYI: Did you know people leave money to A.A. in their wills?

Yes, bequests in wills are acceptable only from A.A. members on a one-time basis, and not in perpetuity. The limit is \$5000.00. If you would like the bequest be given to Memphis Area Intergroup Association it must be stipulated in that manner; otherwise if your will says Alcoholics Anonymous the funds will go directly to the General Service of Alcoholics Anonymous in New York. Their legal name is the General Service of Alcoholics Anonymous.
